### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION.

#### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- I agree to the Club utilising my registration information under the provisions of the Privacy Act 1993 and authorise the Club to supply details to the Club Team Managers and Coaches, AHA or the NZHF for the purposes of hockey administration.

#### 2012 FEES

- School Year 7-8                 \$175 per player
- School Year 5-6                 \$155 per player
- School Year 3-4                 \$120 per player
- School Year 1-2                 \$ 90 per player

#### FEE PAYMENT

- Team places will only be guaranteed following full payment of all Club fees no later than 26<sup>th</sup> Feb of the current year – this completes registration.
- Players can not attend club trials unless full payment of the fees are made by the date of the first pre-season Junior Division trial – 4 March 2012. (Trials are only for experienced year 5-8 players only).
- Cancellation of registration for any player will occur on failure to make full payment by the date of the first pre-season Junior Division trial.
- Note: For those having difficulty making payment, arrangements can be made to make payment by two separate cheques of half payment each – one to be current and the other post-dated to 31 March.
- Fees will not be refunded if cancellation or withdrawal occurs after 1<sup>st</sup> March of the current year.
